The position will support an inclusive environment where all families are respected and valued for their diversity and children are celebrated. This position requires a Family Support Certificate or Bachelors Degree in Social Work and/or Child and Youth Care.

Our team includes people of all Indigenous identities; some who are close to their communities and others who are on a path to learn more about their heritage.
